

MEMORANDUM.

This Return is presented in obedience to the Order of the House of Commons of the 28th June 1917. It continues the Tables given in the Parliamentary Paper, No. 118 of 1916, for the Year 1915-16. But for the purposes of convenience it also reproduces part of the figures given in the earlier Return, namely, those for the decennial periods up to and including 1909-1910 and those for the three years immediately preceding 1916-17.

For the decennial period commencing 1900-1 the mean of the figures of the years 1909-10 and 1910-11 have been taken rather than those for 1909-10. As explained on page 16 of the Parliamentary Paper 220+ of 1911 the figures for 1909-10, owing to the delay in passing the Finance Bill of 1909, and the consequent postponement until 1910-11 of the collection of a large amount of the Revenue proper to 1909-10, afford a very misleading index to the financial position of Great Britain and Ireland in that year.

For an explanation of the basis on which the figures for recent years have been compiled, reference should be made to the Memorandum contained in Parliamentary Paper, No. 313 of 1894, to the Financial Relations (England, Scotland and Ireland) Papers (Nos. 93, 305, and 334 of 1893), and to the Returns of Revenue and Expenditure (England, Scotland, and Ireland) which have been issued in subsequent years.

Note.

Local expenditure of a considerable amount is at present met from the Votes of Credit, but, so far, it has not been possible during the War to allocate these charges on any satisfactory basis between Great Britain and Ireland, and all Vote of Credit charges are consequently excluded from the Tables on pages 16-21 of this Return.

In the case of Revenue it is possible to allocate the produce of special taxation (e.g., Excess Profits Duty), and such revenue is included in the Tables on pages 4-15 of the Return.
