REPORT of the COMPTROLLER and AUDITOR GENERAL upon the Account of the Intermediate Education Board, Ireland, for the Year ended the 31st December 1889; prepared and submitted for the Information of Parliament, in pursuance of the 10th Section of the Act 41 & 42 Vict. c. 66.

1. The Capital under the control of the Board of Intermediate Education for Ireland has been further reduced by the sale of 3,100 l. Two and Three-quarters per Cent. Stock, which realised 3,005 l. 0 s. 9 d. This amount was transferred to the Income Account.

The balance of Securities on Capital Account consequently now stands at 1,009,761 l. 4 s. 9 d., as compared with 1,012,861 l. 4 s. 9 d., as shown at the close of the preceding Account.

2. The subjoined statement of Assets and Liabilities prepared by the Accounting Officer shows an Excess of Assets on 31st December 1889, amounting to 1,766 l.

To this should be added the sum of 31, being the amount of a payment reported for disallowance on last year's Account, not yet brought to credit by the Accountant.

There should also be added a further sum of 1 l. 10 s. 9 d., the amount of a Results Fee paid in error, and charged against this year's Account.

- 3. The Cost of Administration and of Examinations during the year 1889, amounted to 12,643 l. 14 s. 11 d., showing an increase of 396 l. 12 s. 9 d., over the amount expended on the same services in the year 1888.
- 4. The expenditure in respect of Rewards and Results Fees during the year 1889 amounted to 23,171 l. 16 s. 7 d., according to the Accounting Officer's Statement (the audited amount being 23,170 l. 5 s. 10 d., or 1 l. 10 s. 9 d. less, as explained in paragraph 2), as compared with 26,190 l. 17 s. 10 d. in the preceding year, showing a decrease of 3,020 l. 12 s.


