It was resolved to introduce into the National Historical and Portrait Gallery autograph writings of persons therein represented from time to time as opportunities offer, and a collection of 20 such was presented by Richard Green, Esq., containing, amongst others, autographs of Grattan, Curran, Plunkett and O'Connell. A letter written by Thomas Moore relating to it, was included in the purchase of his portrait by Jackson: and an autograph of one of his melodies, both words and music in his handwriting, was purchased for £2.

Three solid screens were erected down the centre of the Historical and Portrait Gallery for the exclusive exhibition of the Mezzotints presented by Sir Edward Cecil Guinness, Bart., 80 of the choicest of which were framed and glazed and arranged early in the month of August.

At the special request of the Committee of the Arts and Manufactures (Jubilee) Exhibition of Manchester, the following pictures were lent for the term of the

The Pictures by Luca Signorelli, Van de Velde, Ruysdael and De Keyser, Van Bergen, Harlowe and Hoppner-all the above, together with the Picture by Wouwerman, were glazed.

The following were framed as well as glazed—The Pictures by Luca Signorelli, Watts, Cregan, and Rothwell; also the Drawings of Lord O'Hagan, Bishop Jebb, and Lord Tyrconnell, and the 80 Mezzotints mentioned above.

The Portrait of Thomas Moore, by Jackson, and the Picture by Luca Signorelli were placed in glazed mahogany cases.
