

Be it therefore Chacted, by The KING's most Excellent MAJESTY, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Tem-5 poral, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, THAT all and every of the Powers and Provisions vested in the Commissioners for building Gaols in Ireland by the said recited Act of the fiftieth year of the reign of his late Majesty King George the Third, and by the said recited Act of the seventh year 10 of his late Majesty King George the Fourth, and that all the Powers vested in the Commissioners for the establishment of Lunatic Asylums in Ireland by the said recited Act of the first and second years of the reign of his said late Majesty King George the Fourth, shall be and are hereby vested in the Governors of the several Infirmaries and Hos-15 pitals of the several Counties, and Counties of Cities and Towns in Ireland, so far as the same relate to the holding the Court, issuing Warrants or Precepts for Juries, and to the Valuation of the Lands, Tenements and Hereditaments on the Site of which any Infirmary or Hospital shall or may have been or may be erected, regulated or incor-20 porated under and by virtue of any Act in force in Ireland, or which may be required for any Addition to such Infirmary or Infirmaries or Hospital or Hospitals, or to the Yards or Grounds surrounding or adjoining the same; and that all the Provisions as to Notices, Proceedings, Verdicts, Judgments, Conveyances and Inrolments, and all other matters relating to the Valuation of Premises in said recited Acts mentioned, shall be held to apply to the Valuation of Lands, Tenements or Hereditaments for the Sites or Additions of and to such Infirmaries and Hospitals; and such Verdicts, Judgments and Conveyances shall be binding and conclusive to all intents and purposes whatsoever.
