Confirm certain Provisional Orders of the Local Govern- A.D. 1903.
ment Board for Ireland relating to Belfast (Rural)
Ennistymon (Rural) and Londonderry and the Rathdrum
and Wicklow Joint Burial Board District.

WHEREAS the Local Government Board for Ireland (herein-
after referred to as "the Local Government Board") have
made the Provisional Orders set forth in the schedule hereto under
the Public Health (Ireland) Acts 1878 to 1896 :

5 And whereas it is requisite that the said Orders should be
confirmed by Parliament and that the provisions herein contained
should be enacted with reference to one of such Orders :

Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty
by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and
10 Temporal and Commons in this present Parliament assembled
and by the authority of the same as follows :—

1. The Orders set out in the schedule hereto are hereby Orders
confirmed and all the provisions thereof shall have full validity in schedule
and force. confirmed.

15 2. The Corporation mentioned in the Order relating to the
county borough of Londonderry hereby confirmed shall not under
the powers of that Order purchase or acquire ten or more houses
which on the fifteenth day of December last were occupied either
wholly or partially by persons belonging to the labouring class
20 as tenants or lodgers or except with the consent of the Local
Government Board ten or more houses which were not so occupied
on the said fifteenth day of December but have been or will be
subsequently so occupied.

The expression "labouring class" means mechanics artizans labourers and others working for wages hawkers costermongers persons not working for wages but working at some trade or handicraft without employing others except members of their own families and persons other than domestic servants whose income 5 does not exceed an average of thirty shillings a week and the families of any of such persons who may be residing with them.

3. This Act may be cited as the Local Government Board (Ireland) Provisional Orders Confirmation (No. 4) Act 1903.

of the powers given to us by section 203 of the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1878
and of all other powers enabling Us in that behalf do hereby order that from
and after the date of the Act confirming this Order the following provisions
shall have effect namely:—

1. The district council acting as the burial board of the district shall be
empowered to put in force with reference to the lands described in the
schedule hereto and for the purpose aforesaid the powers of the Lands Clauses
Acts as amended by section 8 of the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1896 with
20 respect to the purchase and taking of lands otherwise than by agreement or
any of them.

2. The costs and expenses of the district council and the Local Government
Board for Ireland incurred in respect of the application for preparation
making and confirmation of this Order shall be paid by the district council
25 and the money required for that purpose shall be supplied by the county
council of Antrim in the manner provided by the Local Government (Ireland)
Act 1898 as part of the expenses of the district council.

3. This Order may be cited as the Carnmoney Burial Ground Order 1903.

RATHDRUM AND WICKLOW JOINT BURIAL BOARD.

*Rathdrum and
Wicklow.*

Provisional Order.

WHEREAS the rural district of Rathdrum and the urban district of Wicklow were by the Rathdrum and Wicklow Joint Burial Board Provisional Order 1900 (in this Order referred to as "the Order of 1900") confirmed by the 5
Local Government Board (Ireland) Provisional Orders Confirmation (No. 3) Act 1900 (in this Order referred to as "the Act of 1900") formed into a united district, for the purposes in the Order of 1900 mentioned:

And whereas an application has been made to the Local Government Board for Ireland (in this Order referred to as "the Local Government Board") by the council of the rural district of Rathdrum (in this Order referred to as "the rural authority") for a provisional order altering the Act of 1900: 10

And whereas it appears to the Local Government Board expedient that the said Act should be altered as herein-after provided: 15

Now therefore We the Local Government Board in pursuance of the powers given to Us by section 214 of the Public Health (Ireland) Act 1878 and of all other powers enabling Us in that behalf do hereby order that from and after the date of the Act confirming this Order the following provisions shall have effect namely,— 20

1. The Act of 1900 so far as it relates to the Order of 1900 shall be altered by the omission from Article 11 of the said Order (which provides for the proportion in which the expenses of the joint board are to be contributed) of the words "in the manner provided by section 235 of the Act" and by the substitution therefor of the words "in proportion to the rateable value of the 25
" property in the Wicklow rural district electoral division and the urban
" district of Wicklow respectively such value to be ascertained according to
" the valuation list in force for the time being".

2. The costs and expenses of the rural authority and the Local Government Board incurred in respect of the application for preparation making 30
and confirmation of this Order shall be paid by the rural authority and the money required for that purpose shall be supplied by the County Council of Wicklow in the manner provided by the Local Government (Ireland) Act 1898 as part of the expenses of the rural authority.

3. This Order may be cited as the Rathdrum and Wicklow Joint Burial Board Provisional Order 1903. 35
