REPORT of the Comptroller and Auditor General upon the Account of the Irish Land Commission, in respect of Church Temporalities in Ireland, for the Year ended 31st March 1903, prepared and submitted to Parliament in pursuance of the 37th Section of the Act 32 & 33 Vict. c. 42.

Administration.

1. The administration of the Fund, which was originally vested in the Irish Church Administration. Temporalities Commissioners, was transferred to the Land Commission in 1881.

Receipts.

2. The receipts for the year amounted to 596,5541. 15s. 2d., including the balance of Receipts. 59,1471. 4s. 1d. brought forward from the previous year. After providing for the payment of the various charges detailed in the Account, balances of 37,9851. 9s. 3d. Cash, and 223,3301. 4s. 6d. Guaranteed Land Stock, remained on hand at the 31st March 1903.

Expenditure.

3. The outstanding loans made under the Seed Potatoes Supply Act, 1895, alluded to Interest under Seed in paragraph 4 of my report of last year, were paid off during the year 1901-2. Supply, &c. (Irelatest, however, continues to be paid out of the Church Fund to the Board of Works land) Act, 1898.

on certain outstanding leans made under the provisions of the Seed Supply and Potato Spraying (Ireland) Act, 1898, although under Section 2 (2) of the Act the leans should have been repaid by the Guardians by 1st September 1900.

4. As pointed out in the second paragraph of my Report on the Appropriation Balance.

Account of the Irish Land Commission, Class III., Vote 16, a sum of 9811. 12s. 3d. was Default of cashier. charged, with the sanction of the Treasury, to a Special Sub-Head, "Loss by Default," to make good the defalcations of a late cashier. Of this amount 2381. 15s. 3d. belonged to the Irish Church Temporalities Fund, and is included in the balance of 37,9851. 9s. 3d. standing at the foot of the account.

Collection Account (page 19).

5. The arrear of Tithe Rent-charge, &c. outstanding on 31st March 1902 was Arrears. 73,250l. 19s. 3d.

It is satisfactory to notice that a substantial reduction has been made during the year, the outstanding amount on 31st March 1903 being 57,956l. 5s. 4d.

Capital Liabilities in respect of Advances, &c. (page 20).

6. The capital liabilities of the Irish Church Fund have, in the year to 31st March Capital Liabilities. 1903, been reduced from 5,771,500l. to 5,571,500l. These figures are exclusive of the annuities of 20,000l. payable to the Royal University of Ireland, under the Royal University of Ireland Act, 1881, and of 70,000l. payable to the Department of Agriculture under the Agriculture and Technical Instruction (Ireland) Act, 1899.

Of the liability of 700,000l. under the Arrears of Rent (Ireland) Act, 1882 (45 & 46 Vict. c. 47), outstanding on 31st March 1902, the sum of 200,000l. has been paid off during the year ended 31st March 1903

Relief of Distress (Ireland) Acts, 1880 (page 20).

7. The balance outstanding on the 31st March 1903, on account of advances made to Relief of Distress the Commissioners of Public Works under the Relief of Distress (Ireland) Acts, 1880 Acts. (43 Vict. c. 4, and 43 & 44 Vict. c. 14), was 393,1971. 18s. 1d., of which 5,9921. 9s. 2d. is stated to be regarded as irrecoverable. The arrears on these Loans on 31st March 1903 amounted to 10,823l. 3s. 7d., as stated in paragraph 5 of my Report on the Appropriation Account of the Vote for the Public Works Office, Ireland (Class II., Vote 38), 1902-3.
