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AGRICULTURAL PRICES IN IRELAND, 1881-1914.

This Return shows that there has been a marked increase in the prices obtained in recent years for Irish Agricultural Produce in Irish markets, and that the Irish Farmer's cash income has increased; but against this must be set the increase in his cash expenditure, due to the rise in prices of commodities the farmer purchases, increased wages he pays to labourers, etc.
