

Agriculture and Technical Instruction (Ireland) (No. 2) Bill.

MEMORANDUM.

37 Sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Probate Duty (Scotland and Ireland) Act, 1888 (51 & 52 Vict. c. 60), provides that 5,000l., being part of the sums paid in respect of the Probate Duty Grant to the Local Taxation (Ireland) Account, shall be paid annually to the Royal Dublin Society for the improvement of the breed of horses and cattle.

The Bill proposes to transfer the administration of this sum to the Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland.

BE it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows :

- 5 1. The sum of five thousand pounds payable to the Royal Dublin Society under subsection (1) of section three of the Probate Duties (Scotland and Ireland) Act, 1888, shall be paid annually by the Lord Lieutenant to the Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland, and shall be expended in such
10 manner as the Department may consider expedient for the improvement of the breed of horses and cattle.
- Payment to Department of annual sum formerly payable to Royal Dublin Society.

2. This Act may be cited as the Agriculture and Technical Instruction (Ireland) (No. 2) Act, 1902, and may be cited with the Agriculture and Technical Instruction (Ireland) Acts, 1899 to 1902.
