MEMORANDUM.

Sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Probate Duty (Scotland and Ireland) Act, 1888 (51 & 52 Vict. c. 60), provides that 5,000*l*., being part of the sums paid in respect of the Probate Duty Grant to the Local Taxation (Ireland) Account, shall be paid annually to the Royal Dublin Society for the improvement of the breed of horses and cattle.

The Bill proposes to transfer the administration of this sum to the Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction for Ireland.




