SIR,

I have the honour to submit the Annual General Abstracts of Agricultural Statistics for Ireland, which give, by Counties and Provinces, the acreage under Crops, and the number and description of Live Stock in Ireland in 1901.

The materials necessary for the compilation of these Statistics were obtained by members of the Royal Irish Constabulary and Metropolitan Police, who discharged this important duty with zeal and efficiency.

The Abstracts, which have been carefully compiled from summaries made by the Enumerators, may in some slight degree differ from the revised figures which will be subsequently published.

DIVISION OF LAND.

The following Table shows, by Provinces, the total area (in statute acres) under Crops, Grass, Fallow, Woods and Plantations, Turf Bog, Marsh, Barren Mountain Land, Water, Roads, Fences, &c., in 1900 and 1901:—

The total area under crops in 1901 is 4,630,480 acres, being, as compared with the area in 1900, a decrease of 28,252 acres, or 0·6 per cent. There was an increase in the area under crops in Connaught of 1,174 acres, or 0·2 per cent.; but a decrease in Munster of 11,519 acres, or 1·0 per cent.; in Leinster, of 10,891 acres, or 0·9 per cent.; and in Ulster, of 6,984 acres, or 0·4 per cent.

In 1900 the area returned under grass was 10,563,372 acres; in 1901 the amount returned is 10,578,409 acres, being an **increase** of 15,037 acres; the area returned as fallow in 1900 was 12,589 acres, and in 1901, 10,967 acres; the area under woods and plantations was 311,648 acres in 1900, and 308,962 acres in 1901; and the area returned under "Turf Bog, Marsh, Barren Mountain Land, &c.," was 4,787,003 acres in 1900, and 4,804,526 acres in 1901, being an increase of 17,523 acres; of the area thus returned in 1901, 1,161,301 acres have been entered by the enumerators as turf bog, 410,789 acres as marsh, and 2,226,121 acres as barren mountain land.

TOTAL AREA UNDER CROPS.

Cereal Crops.—Compared with 1900 there appears a **decrease** of 10,901 acres in the area under wheat; a **decrease** of 5,647 acres under oats; a **decrease** of 12,497 acres under barley; a **decrease** of 430 acres under bere and rye, and a **decrease** of 124 acres under beans and pease; showing a net **decrease** of 29,599 acres in the area under cereal crops.

Green Crops.—The area under potatoes has **decreased** by 18,739 acres; that under turnips by 8,010 acres; and carrots, parsnips, and other green crops by 1,670 acres; mangel wurzel and beet root **increased** by 8,634 acres; cabbage by 573 acres; and vetches and rape by 264 acres, leaving a net **decrease** of 18,948 acres in the area under green crops.

Flax.—The area under flax in 1900 was 47,451 acres; the area returned under this crop in 1901 is 55,471 acres, being an **increase** of 8,020 acres, or 16·9 per cent.

In the returns the area under **meadow** and **clover** is shown as the area "For Hay only," subdivided under the headings "Clover, sainfoin, and grasses under rotation" and "Permanent pasture, or grass *not broken up in rotation.*" The area for hay under "Clover, &c.," in 1900, was 607,380 acres: this year it is 617,211 acres, being an **increase** of 9,831 acres. The area for hay on permanent pasture in 1900 was 1,558,335 acres, and in 1901 it is 1,560,779 acres, showing an **increase** of 2,444 acres. There is, therefore, an increase of 12,275 acres in the total area under meadow and clover.

RETURNS OF LIVE STOCK.

It appears from the following Table that between 1900 and 1901 there has been a **decrease** of 4,104 in the number of horses and mules. The mules decreased by 1,796 and horses by 2,308. Cattle, on the other hand, exhibit an **increase** of 63,485, while there has been a **decrease** of 8,231 in sheep, and of 49,475 in the number of pigs. Of the 18,807,766 poultry enumerated in 1901, 1,124,795 were turkeys, 1,962,161 were geese, 3,040,897 were ducks, and 12,679,913 were ordinary fowl.
