# THE REPORT

OF THE

## PRESIDENT OF THE QUEEN'S COLLEGE, CORK,

FOR

THE SESSION 1903-1904.

TO THE KING'S MOST EXCELLENT MAJESTY.

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR MAJESTY :

I have, with my very humble duty, to submit a Report on the condition of Queen's College, Cork, for the Session 1903-1904.

The number of students attending the College during this Session was 225, as against 190 during the Session 1902-1903. Of the 225 students 212 were matriculated, and 13 non-matriculated. The number of new students was 65. Of these 52 came from the Royal University of Ireland, 9 from other Colleges and Universities, and 7 were not matriculated.

During the Session the work done in College has been thorough, and this remark applies in a special degree to the Pathological Department. Dr. Moore, the Lecturer in Pathology, has, since his appointment, altered the methods of teaching this subject, and the Post Graduate Classes, which he directs, have added largely to the usefulness and distinction of the College. I must again, however, call attention to the circumstance that, although Dr. Moore devotes his whole time to teaching Pathology, he, nevertheless, receives no salary, and I must insist once more on the prime importance of establishing and endowing adequately a chair of Pathology. But, indeed, as I have often pointed out before, if science is to be efficiently taught in practical classes here it is essential that the number of professors and assistants should be considerably increased. The present arrangements, which have practically existed since the opening of the College, are much behind modern requirements.

At the Second Medical Examination at the Royal University last spring one of our students was awarded second class honours and an exhibition. I regret to have, however, to state that there is a decided indisposition on the part of medical students of Queen's College, Cork, to read for honours in the Royal University. The explanation will be found in the evidence given before the recent Royal Commission by several professors of the College. The proportion of Medical Examiners from Cork in the Royal

University is inadequate. At present on each of the Medical Boards of the Second and Third Medical Examinations there is only one examiner from Cork, while there are three from Belfast and three from Dublin. It is not alleged that Cork students are treated unfairly, but, as Dr. Charles pointed out, "it is only natural that they should become disheartened, when they find themselves on a very different footing with regard to the 'personnel' of the examining Boards from that of their rivals from Belfast and Dublin." [Dr. Charles' evidence, p. 167, Report.] The result is, that gifted and promising Cork medical students feel disinclined to prepare for the Honour Examinations of the Royal University, and that a large number of them seek their qualifications from the Royal Colleges of Surgeons and Physicians of Dublin and Edinburgh.

I am assured by those who, in my opinion, are authorities in this matter, that no improvement in this state of things will take place so long as the University arrangements continue as at present.

The claims of Cork to obtain an examinership in chemistry in the Royal University have not yet been satisfied, notwithstanding the unquestioned distinction of Dr. Dixon, the Professor of Chemistry in Cork, and although these claims are evident and great.

I have only to add, that the satisfactory state of things, and marked tendency to improvement, in the College, to which the Visitors bore testimony at the statutory visitation last year, continued during the Session. The tone and conduct of the students has been excellent, and nothing occurred to disturb the harmony which has existed in the College since I have had the high honour of being its President.
