

TAXING MASTERS, COURT OF CHANCERY (IRELAND).

RETURN to an Order of the Honourable The House of Commons,
dated 23 April 1849;—for,

RETURN “ of the NUMBER and AMOUNT of the BILLS of COSTS lodged for TAXATION in the Office of the TAXING MASTERS of the COURT of CHANCERY in *Ireland*, from the 1st day of November 1845 to the 13th day of September 1848; distinguishing those handed over from the Masters’ Offices, and those lodged, from the 13th day of September 1848 to the 31st day of December 1848, and from the 31st day of December 1848 to the 1st day of March 1849; the Number and Amount of the Bills certified in said Class, and of those remaining untaxed in each of those Periods; the Number and Amount of all the BILLS of COSTS remaining untaxed on the 1st day of March 1849; and the Number and Amount of said untaxed Bills on which no Summons has ever been issued.”
