Memorandum.—These "Fines and Penalties" Accounts are rendered from the date of the last rendered to Parliament for 1848 (Sessional Paper, No 376, 1850). The accounts for the years 1849 and 1850 are each for a single complete year; that for 1851 begins on the 1st January, and terminates on the 31st October; the next contains the last two months of 1851, and the whole year 1852, and the three first months of 1853. These broken periods complete the whole time continuously, from 1st January 1849 to 31st March 1853. The apparent irregularity arises from the changes from the Second Remembrancer's to the Chief Secretary's Office, and from the new Act not coming into operation at the beginning or end of a year, but on the 1st November 1853. The accounts terminate with a clear Parliamentary year, and will so proceed henceforth year by year.
